SACRAMENTS

Please contact the office by email, which is leicester.admin@english.op.org for any of the following:

- Infant Baptisms, Marriages, Becoming Catholic: Please apply to the parish office by email or talk to one of the priests.
- Visiting the Sick: If you would like a visit, either send an email or leave a telephone message with your name, tel. no. & address.
- First Communion: classes have begun for children who are not receiving catechism at school, so it is now too late to enrol new children. But there will be more classes next year, so please let one of the priests know.
- **Confirmation:** once the First Communions have taken place, we will start Confirmation classes for any children who need them this will probably be in the autumn. If you are an adult and have not been confirmed, please speak to one of the priests and we will arrange for you to receive the sacrament.

The Dominican priests continue to offer **pastoral care to the LRI**, in collaboration with the University Hospitals of Leicester (UHL) NHS Trust. **If you or a relative are in hospital, please ask the nurse to inform the hospital chaplain. If someone is dying, ask the duty nurse to call the Catholic chaplain** – do not call yourself.

CONFESSIONS ON SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS

There is a huge demand for Confessions on Saturday lunchtimes, so much so that sometimes we are not able to get through everybody before the 12.30 Mass starts. Of course it is wonderful that so many people, parishioners and others from far and wide, want to avail themselves of this important sacrament. So we have decided that, from 9th June onwards, Confessions will also be available from 6 p.m. until 6.45 p.m. on Sundays. During this time the Blessed Sacrament is exposed, and there is Benediction at 6.45, so we would encourage you to come early and pray before the Sacrament while waiting for Confession. Please note that we will stop hearing Confessions at 6.45 sharp, and also at 12.15 sharp on Saturdays.

PARISH GROUPS

SCRIPTURE STUDY: we have started up again after a long Easter break, and we have started reading from St John's Gospel. There are very lively and interesting discussions, and I would strongly urge you to consider joining if you have not been before.
