A MESSAGE FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

Dear brothers and sisters,

I hope you all had a wonderful summer! As the new school and university terms begin, let us especially remember our young people in our prayers and ask the Lord to guide them and strengthen them.

On Sunday 15 September we will be celebrating our Patronal Feast, the Solemnity of the Triumph of the Cross. This is an occasion when we not only celebrate the power of Christ's love, overcoming death on the Cross and opening the gates of paradise, but also celebrate our community. It is a good opportunity for us to renew our commitment to the parish and the life of the Church.

The day before that, we will be welcoming people who don't usually come into our church in the annual Ride & Stride event – see below for more details.

And the new term means we will be beginning classes for First Communion and also Confirmation – again, please see below for more information.

OUR LADY'S INTENTIONS

Many of you have already spotted the box near the Lady Chapel for prayer intentions. Just write your intentions on one of the slips of paper and put it in the box, and Mass will be offered for all those intentions every Saturday morning. There is a grey money box near the box where you can put any donation you would like to offer, to help support the brethren.

RIDE & STRIDE

Ride & Stride is an annual fund-raising event on behalf of the Leicestershire Historic Churches Trust which gives grants to historic churches and chapels. Over the years Holy Cross has received a number of grants from the Trust. There's more information at <u>www.lhct.org.uk</u>.

The aim is to get people to sponsor you to visit as many churches as possible on the day by bike or on foot. Some 10 open churches are within easy walking distance of Holy Cross, and Holy Cross will be open all day, with Fr Richard giving a guided tour of the church at 3pm. You don't have to participate in the day to join the guided tour, but if you're not a participant then a contribution to the day's event will be much appreciated.

SACRAMENTS

Please contact the office by email, which is **leicester.admin@english.op.org** for any of the following:

- Infant Baptisms, Marriages, Becoming Catholic: Please apply to the parish office by email or talk to one of the priests.
- Visiting the Sick: If you would like a visit, either send an email or leave a telephone message with your name, tel. no. & address.
- First Communion and Confirmation: If your child needs to make first Communion and is not doing so through school, please ask a priest for a green form. We expect classes to start up again after Christmas. There will be two sets of Confirmation classes beginning in the autumn: one for children, and one for unconfirmed adults. If you have a child of confirmation age, please ask for a green form; if you are an adult but have not been confirmed, please make yourself known to Fr Richard, or listen out for further announcements.

The Dominican priests continue to offer **pastoral care to the LRI**, in collaboration with the University Hospitals of Leicester (UHL) NHS Trust. **If you or a relative are in hospital, please ask the nurse to inform the hospital chaplain. If someone is dying, ask the duty nurse to call the Catholic chaplain** – do not call yourself.

CONFESSIONS

Confessions are now available from 6 p.m. until 6.45 p.m. on Sundays as well as on Saturday mornings. During this time the Blessed Sacrament is exposed, and there is Benediction at 6.45, so we would encourage you to come early and pray before the Sacrament while waiting for Confession. Please note that we will stop hearing Confessions at 6.45 sharp, and also at 12.15 sharp on Saturdays.

PARISH GROUPS

SCRIPTURE STUDY: we are continuing to read from St John's Gospel. There are very lively and interesting discussions, and I would strongly urge you to consider joining if you have not been before. We meet in the Frassati Centre on Tuesday evenings at 7.45 for about an hour, and all are welcome, including older children if accompanied by a parent or guardian. Please bring a Bible!
