ADVENT MOSES BASKET APPEAL

During the season of Advent and Christmas, we aim to support a local charity, *Baby Basics*. They collect second hand and new items donated by local people and redistribute them to people in need who are expecting a baby. Referrals are made to Baby Basics by midwives, health visitors, social workers, refugee agencies, housing officers and other professionals. The aim is to ensure every baby has a safe place to sleep and the basic items needed for their care by providing a basic Moses basket starter pack. We are appealing for donations of specific items to go in the Moses basket starter packs:

Newborn clothing (especially babygrows), 0-3 month clothing, small blankets and sheets for Moses basket, baby towels, baby sleeping bags, board books, rattles and also Moses baskets. Second hand items must be washed and in good condition. There will be a collection point at Holy Cross Church. Thank you for your generosity.

SACRAMENTS

- **Infant Baptisms, Marriages, Becoming a Catholic:** Please apply to the parish office by email or talk to one of the priests.
- **Visiting the Sick:** If you would like a visit, either send an email or leave a telephone message with your name, tel. no. & address.
- First Communion and Confirmation: If your child needs to make first Communion and is not doing so through school, please ask a priest for a green form. We expect classes to start up again after Christmas, and First Communions will take place on the Feast of Corpus Christi, 22 June. There will be two sets of Confirmation classes beginning in the autumn: one for children, and one for unconfirmed adults. If you have a child of confirmation age, please ask for a green form; if you are an adult but have not been confirmed, please make yourself known to Fr Richard, or listen out for further announcements. The Bishop will be coming to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on Sunday 4 May.

The Dominican priests continue to offer **pastoral care to the LRI**, in collaboration with the University Hospitals of Leicester (UHL) NHS Trust. **If you or a relative are in hospital, please ask the nurse to inform the hospital chaplain. If someone is dying, ask the duty nurse to call the Catholic chaplain** – do not call yourself.
